Saint Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland. *St Patrick's Day* is 17th March. He was a 5th century apostle is credited with bringing Christianity to Ireland and was probably responsible in part for the Christianization of the Picts and Anglo-Saxons. Born in Roman Britain he was captured by Irish pirates at about 14 yrs old and taken to Ireland as a slave to herd and tend sheep. He is buried in Down Cathedral, Down Patrick.
