

Recorder Lessons

From the beginning of October, Year 3 music lessons will focus on learning to play the descant recorder. This is a good ‘starter’ instrument, which will help extend the children’s musical knowledge and enable them to start reading music notation.

For hygiene reasons, each child will need their own recorder. We do have a number of clean, second-hand recorders in school. **If you would like your child to borrow one of these, free of charge, please indicate this on the reply slip below.** *We ask that you replace the recorder if it gets lost or damaged and that you return it washed at the end of the year.*

Alternatively, you can purchase your own **descant recorder** – Amazon sells them for as little as £5 and they come in all sorts of interesting colours! **Yamaha** is a recommended make. If you are supplying your own recorder, please indicate that on the slip below. We will be following the book ***Razzamajazz*** (Recorder Book 1) by Sarah Watts, which comes with a CD, making practising at home much more fun! This book is also available from Amazon, but there is no obligation to buy it.

Recorders must be in school each Friday from 5th October. If you have any queries, please let me or Mrs Formby know.
