Y2 will be participating in this years '**Outdoor Classroom Day**' on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May. The children will be carrying out a selection of activities that showcase the natural environment all around us.

Some examples of the activities are: -

- Exploring habitats in Silver Hall Park.
- Looking at the four elements of nature: **Earth** – clay modelling, **Fire** – cooking on a BBQ, **Air** – making kites to fly, **Water** - building and sailing their own boats.
- In addition, we will be looking at sustainability and how single use plastics are very bad for the environment. The children will design a new water bottle that does not use plastic.

We need a little help from you!

1. Could you help the children to find and bring in examples of nature – stones, pebbles, leaves, moss, flowers, twigs and shells. **Please do not send in Living creatures like snails.**
2. Send in any plastic that you use over the course of the week, so we can build a plastic mountain. **We will recycle it afterwards.**
3. Any cardboard and junk modelling materials, including washed tin cans etc (**no sharp edges please**)
