As part of our historical topic work this half of term, we will be taking our classes to The Weald and Downland Living Museum, in West Sussex on **Friday 11th May**. The children will be taking part in workshops, experiencing life as Anglo-Saxon children and fully immersing themselves in a mock Anglo-Saxon village. This is a unique opportunity for the children to experience this era of history in such a location.
