**RE: WW1 Remembrance Parade Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> of November**

As part of the commemorations of the start of WW1, several schools in Isleworth are taking part in a project called Isleworth 390.

The project involves 390 pupils from seven different schools wading in the parade on Remembrance Sunday. Each child will wear a sash bearing the name of one of the 390 soldiers whose names appear on the Isleworth War Memorial.

Our year 6 children have been invited to represent the school in the Isleworth Remembrance Day Walk. We are asking for 5 volunteer children to attend on the Sunday (along 1-2 parent helpers to assist).

The walk will start at the central meeting area (the green area, opposite the Blue School, on Swan Street) just before 10am on Sunday the 12<sup>th</sup> of November and should finish just before midday. Students will be expected to wear their neatest school uniform.

Please complete and return the consent form attached, by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> of October, if you would like your child to be part of this historical and wholly unique event. Should we receive more than 5 applications then students who returned their forms on the due name will be drawn from a hat at random and students informed by the end of the week.
